



## JOIN THE CLEAN & GREEN PROGRAM

Since 2011, Clean & Green has enlisted the help of over 60 businesses and civic groups totaling 1,650 volunteers who adopted an area or neighborhood of downtown, rolled up their sleeves, and made a difference. Through their efforts, Downtown Chattanooga and surrounding neighborhoods are cleaner and greener! This improvement to downtown assists in a higher quality of life for Chattanoogaans by attracting visitors, residents, reducing crime, encouraging new businesses and more than anything – instilling pride in the city we all call home.

### CLEAN & GREEN YIELDS RESULTS

Over the two years that Clean & Green has occurred, over 3,000 bags of trash have been collected; graffiti has been removed from over 100 buildings and monuments; 55 city blocks have been cleaned multiple times; downtown greenery has been tended to; and problems with city infrastructure like vandalism, potholes, and damaged bus stops have been reported.

### CLEAN & GREEN DAY

Clean & Green will occur Saturday, April 6th from 8:30am to 12pm. Teams are asked to meet in Miller Plaza, 850 Market Street, to sign in and receive their supplies (i.e. trash bags, gloves, graffiti remover) along with enjoying the provided breakfast prior to heading out to their assigned area.

### CLEAN & GREEN COVERAGE AREA

Clean & Green teams will cover the entire downtown area, including the NorthShore, Riverfront, City Center, MLK/University, and Southside districts and many downtown neighborhoods including Jefferson Heights, Cowart Place, Ft. Negley, Highland Park, Orchard Knob, Fort Wood and Hill City.
